Proposals postmarked prior to, but not received until after this deadline will not be accepted. Vendor submittals may not be sent to the City of Sparks via the Internet/e-mail and will not be entertained for award by the City of Sparks. The right is reserved to reject any Proposal or to accept the Proposal which is deemed by the City of Sparks to be in the best interest of the City of Sparks. The City of Sparks reserves the right to waive any irregularities and/or informalities in the proposal process.

All Proposals are to be marked clearly on the outside “RFP/SOQ Number **18/19-007**, for **TMWRF FACILITY PLAN**.”

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility (TMWRF), jointly owned by the Cities of Sparks and Reno, Nevada, intends to engage a consulting firm to complete the 2019 TMWRF Facility Plan (the Plan). The intent is to create a planning document to identify necessary improvements, potentially new processes, equipment and facilities as well as repair or replacement of existing major assets. The planning horizon will be a facility that is capable of treating and discharging of **42 Million Gallons per Day** of municipal wastewater in compliance with all aspects of TMWRF’s NPDES discharge permit.

The work to be performed under this Contract shall be commenced by the successful firm(s) after all executed Contract documents have been submitted for each unique scope of work, and after being notified to proceed by the City of Sparks.
