WASHOE COUNTY REGIONAL ANIMAL SERVICES CODE REVISION PROCESS

- Washoe County Code Chapter 55 has not been updated since inception, 2005
- Several factors are driving the need to update:
 - Legislative changes
 - Department changes
 - Language clarifications/clean up
 - Programs, services and community needs evolve, requiring periodic updates to Code

FERAL CAT CODE

- New code section to facilitate a feral cat management program in Washoe County
 - Sponsor group (501)(c3) will partner with WCRAS to accept, spay/neuter, vaccinate and return cats to a monitored colony
 - Colonies will be monitored by caretakers who are partnering with the Sponsor

ACO POWERS AND DIRECTOR AUTHORITY AND DUTIES

ACO Powers and Duties

 Clarification of enforcement authority

Director Authority and Duties

- Creation of the Department
- Creation of Director of Animal Services

DANGEROUS DOG DETERMINATION (55.750)

Proposed changes will tighten up public safety measures and align with changes to NRS.

- Declaring dog dangerous based solely on breed is prohibited per NRS 202.500
- Increased insurance requirements to dog owner
- Increased caging requirements
- Monitoring of previously declared dangerous dogs entering Washoe County
- Clarification of criteria used to assist in declaring a dog dangerous
