KTMB's Impact in Sparks 2014-15

- ✦ **\$235,964.17** total in-kind support for projects in the City of Sparks
- ✦ **2,315 total volunteers hours** valued at **\$53,407.05**
- ✦ **30,640 pounds of waste removed** from City of Sparks parks and open space areas
- ✦ **92 tires removed** from Sparks open space
- ✦ **7,700 pounds** of invasive and noxious weeds removed from Sparks parks and open space
- ✦ **2,805** Christmas trees recycled

City of Sparks Partnership 2014-15

More than 600 volunteers participated in cleanup, beautification and recycling programs in the City of Reno for a total of **2,315 hours** valued at **\$45,860** (using \$19.81 identified by the state of Nevada as the volunteer value according to independentsector.org)

KTMB removed **30,640 pounds** of trash, invasive and noxious weeds, tires, and abandoned cars from City of Reno parks and open space areas in 2014-15 (**15.3 US tons**)

92 tires were removed from Sparks open space during KTMB's Great Community Cleanup **7,700** pounds of invasive weeds were removed from City of Sparks Parks and river front parks

Total KTMB in-kind support is valued at **\$235,964.17** (program and volunteer coordination, volunteer value, project tools and supplies, community education, and project promotion)

KTMB's Christmas Tree Recycling Program

- ✦ The Christmas Tree Recycling site at Rancho San Rafael kept **2,805 Christmas trees** out of the landfill for use in park beautification and weed abatement projects
- ✦ A record **194 volunteers contributed 776 hours of service** at the Shadow Mountain Christmas Tree Recycling site **for a value of \$17,902.32**
- ✦ **\$4000 in-kind chipping** courtesy of the City of Sparks Maintenance Department and the Nevada Division of Forestry at Shadow Mountain

KTMB's Adopt-A-Spot Program

- ✦ Increased adoption programs in 2015 to include **Adopt-A-River and Adopt-An-Open Space**
- ✦ In the process of recruiting river and open space adopters for the City of Sparks, as well as new roadway adopters
