# A Presentation on the City of Sparks Small Business Assistance Grant Program



City has contracted with the National Development Council (NDC) in the amount of \$45,750 to assist the City.

#### NDC is:

- ➤ Hosting an online application using ZoomGrants.
- Assisting City staff with CARES Act requirements and documentation needed for compliance purposes.
- Reviewing applications and making an initial determination of eligible businesses.

#### NDC (continued):

- Confirming required conditions have been met for initial approvals.
- After initial approval, working with businesses to finalize documentation, including CARES Act eligibility confirmation, to prepare for closing and funding.



## City staff is:

- Reviewing applications NDC has recommended for funding and making final approval decisions; and
- Disbursing funds.



#### **Program Criteria**

- ➤ Must have active State of Nevada and City of Sparks business licenses.
- Must be physically located within the City's corporate boundary.
- ➤ Was legally established and operating as of January 1, 2020 and can demonstrate that the business had generated substantive revenue prior to March 15, 2020.



### **Program Criteria (continued):**

- Must provide documentation demonstrating business has suffered a financial hardship as a result of COVID-19 pandemic.
- > Must submit a plan for how the funds will be utilized.
- ➤ Business that received SBA funding (Economic Injury Disaster Loans & Payroll Protection Program) could apply.

#### **Eligible Uses of Grant Funds**

- ➤ Working capital including utilities, payroll not covered by Payroll Protection Program, and inventory.
- > Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- > Protective business facility retrofits.



#### **Ineligible Businesses**

- Federally prohibited businesses (e.g., cannabis).
- > Adult oriented businesses.
- ➤ Businesses with over 50 employees.
- > Businesses with Federal or State of Nevada tax liens.
- ➤ Non-profit organizations.



#### **Maximum Grant Amounts**

Approximately \$869,000 is available for grants.

#### Working Capital and Retrofit Grants:

> Less than 5 employees \$10,000

> 5 to 19 employees \$20,000

> 20 to 50 employees \$25,000

PPE Grants - up to \$5,000 based on eligible receipts.



#### **Application Statistics**

As of 11/3/20 (initial application period closed 11/2):

A total of 76 applications were submitted.

- > 67 deemed potentially eligible
- > 9 deemed ineligible

Amount of funding requested by potentially eligible applications: \$1,006,801



#### **Program Status**

City staff began final review and approval of eligible applications on 11/3.

After notification of approval, business must execute grant agreement with City.

City staff anticipates beginning to disburse funds week of 11/9.
