

## **Proclamation**

WHEREAS, September 17, 2016, marks the two hundred twenty-ninth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, It is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary; and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS, 2016 is the 61<sup>st</sup> Anniversary of Constitution Week. The celebration of the Constitution was started by the Daughters of the American Revolution in 1955. The D.A.R. petitioned Congress to set aside September 17<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> to be dedicated for the observance of Constitution Week. The resolution was adopted by the U.S. Congress and signed into law on August 2, 1956 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GENO R. MARTINI, Mayor of the City of Sparks, Nevada, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as:
