WHEREAS, the dedicated Sparks police department investigated and helped to bring justice to this tragic event; and

WHEREAS, while evil still lurks among us, it is imperative that our law enforcement agencies continue their steadfast efforts together to eradicate and bring to justice perpetrators of violent crime; and

WHEREAS, in Holly's memory, the City of Sparks created the Holly Quick Memorial at the Sparks Marina as a tribute to Holly and all victims of violent crime; and

WHEREAS, the Holly Quick Memorial provides a place where adults, children, teens and Holly's family members can express their feelings associated with her death and those of others who have died from violence; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sparks and the Alliance for Victim's Rights honor victims and family members of victims of violent crimes and together, remain committed to providing justice and honor.
