

VIRTA Justification

The Sparks Police Department, Range and Training Division, is currently in the process of fulfilling an Edward Byrne Memorial Grant provided through the Office of Criminal Justice Assistance. The grant was approved for the purchase a VIRTRA V-100 Simulator. The choice to go with the VIRTRA when writing the grant was based on diligent research into use of force simulators, their effectiveness in training police officers, benefits to the department, technology available, quality of support and product provided. Below I will address several of these factors.

Modern use of force simulators have come leaps and bounds since their inception. They have been designed to be immersive realistic training in de-escalation, tool use, and force decisions. These things are hot button topics in today's world and while Sparks Police has always taken the training in these areas seriously, we have been hampered by our current technology as well as budget and personnel shortages.

The VIRTRA Simulator helps solve this problem, by providing immersive and responsive deescalation and communications training. The VIRTRA tops the list of companies when it comes to available branching options averaging 85 branching options per scenario. This large number of branching options will allow trainers to train recruits and officers at a near individualized level, making sure to address specific weak points. This is far better than the one size fits all option a lot of available simulators currently use.

One of the strongest markers for imprinting training is realism. If an officer or recruit needs to "suspend their disbelief" unintentional training scars can be created. This is an area VIRTRA excels in, from allowing the use of an officers issued tools, realistic and plausible scenarios, high resolution video/audio and professional actors. Most simulation companies do not spend high dollar on their video production, they use police officers or police officers as their actors, this is not helpful for training, it produces an artificialness that is palpable. VIRTRA utilizes professional actors, which helps provide a sense of realism to the training. The scenarios utilized and created by VIRTRA are often based on real events that have occurred, this makes training easier as real lessons learned can be provided to the learner.

Police officers operate in a high stress world, they often have their lives on the line when dealing with the public. Officers are forced to make instant life or death decisions in situations that are often tense, uncertain, and rapidly evolving. Force decisions are complex and require high level thinking and abilities so that the right decision can be made. It is important that in training we come as near to this stress as we can, this improves the officer's ability to make the right decision under a high amount of stress. This is an area where VIRTRA will provide the department with additional tools. Most use of force simulators utilize a shoot back cannon to add to the trainee's stress, these cannons shoot grape sized plastic balls at the trainee during the scenario. These cannons are controlled by the instructor who must aim it and fire it while also evaluating the trainee. These cannons have multiple downfalls, they can miss, fail to fire, run out of ammunition, or air power. These issues prevent quality training and do not allow for the important stress that encourages officer success in real life.

VIRTRA utilizes a device known as "Threat Fire" that solves these problems. It is a small device that clips to the trainee's belt and provides a small electrical shock to induce stress. This device allows for effective learning and decision making under stress. The device cannot miss and is easily recharged making it more reliable. It is also safer as there are not objects flying around the room and does not require additional downtime for cleanup/set up. In addition, it can be controlled by the trainer or programmed to a specific point in a scenario to provide the safest and most realistic learning.

Due to manpower and budget constraints Sparks Police Department has been required to provide important training via less-than-ideal platforms including online. While these trainings meet the requirements of legislation or POST, it can hardly be argued that they are the most effective means for meaningful learning. VIRTRA helps us solve this problem with the inclusion of the V-VICTA Academy. V-VICTA stands for VIRTRA-Virtual Interactive Coursework Training Academy. Currently V-VICTA offers 60 hours of NV POST approved training via the simulator. Trainings currently provided online can now be provided in this immersive format. These courses are required by POST or legislation and this new format means the Sparks Police Department will be able to provide cutting edge learning that far exceeds the minimum requirements. This part of VIRTRA is constantly growing and is responsive to current trends and needs in law enforcement. Having access to this exclusive program will put Sparks Police Department far ahead of its peers in critical learning domains.

The VIRTRA system will help solve some of the current training and scheduling issues. Where VIRTRA excels is in its support of the purchaser. They can provide needed software updates, diagnostics of issues, and repair of malfunctioning parts. In addition, since VIRTRA's only business if simulators for law enforcement and military, they are responsive to trends and needs in these fields. VIRTRA provides ongoing training to ensure departments are utilizing the equipment effectively and correctly so it is a powerful learning tool and not a giant video game. Ongoing training provided by the manufacturer is a huge benefit to the Sparks Police Department and allied agencies as we can unleash the full potential of simulation training.

While VIRTRA may not be the cheapest option on the surface, the benefits provided make for a far greater return on investment than any other system currently available. Just the V-VICTA portion alone makes VIRTRA a far more powerful tool for training police officers to a higher standard than provided by any other manufacturer. The technology, quality and ongoing support are additional benefits that cannot be ignored. The public demands and deserves high quality police officers, VIRTRA augments our ability to provide the public exactly that, while at the same time saving man hours and money.
