**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF MAINTAINING OPERATIONS AT  
THE RENO PROCESSING AND DISTRIBUTION CENTER**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Postal Service has announced the likelihood of closing the Reno Processing and Distribution Center located at 2000 Vassar Street in Reno; and

**WHEREAS**, the closure of this major postal operation could jeopardize at least 177 jobs in the Truckee Meadows, further impacting a depressed economy struggling to recover; and

**WHEREAS**, closure of the Distribution Center would reduce mail service to northern Nevada, impacting Sparks and Reno; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Postal Service has a constitutional and congressional obligation to provide reliable and efficient mail service.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Sparks City Council that the City Council supports the operations at the Reno Processing and Distribution Center and strongly encourages the United States Postal Service to reconsider closing this critical operation.
