WORKSHOP PURPOSE

- Review proposed S.M.C. amendments for the issuance of business licenses to Medical Marijuana Establishments (MMEs)
- Staff seeking Council direction regarding proposed amendments



BACKGROUND

- □ State of Nevada's regulations for MMEs became effective April 1, 2014
- State has indicated they will open competitive application process for MMEs within 120 days.



BACKGROUND

Four types of MMEs:

- ☐ Cultivation
- □ Production of edibles or infused
 - products
- ☐ Testing laboratories
- □ Dispensaries



BACKGROUND

- ☐ City Council has approved zoning for cultivation, processing and lab facilities. Scheduled to consider zoning for dispensaries on May 27th.
- City would not issue a business license for a MME until the applicant has been provisionally approved by State.



- □ Requires all MMEs operating in Sparks to be licensed per this new section – Chapter 5.80 – of the S.M.C.
- Only individuals (i.e., not business entities) may be licensed.



- May only apply for a City business license after receiving required land use entitlement approval.
- □ Persons qualifying for a "compassionate exception for selfcultivation" required to register with City but not subject to fees.



- ☐ MME business license may be revoked by City Council (see Sec. 5.80.100-110).
- Expires if individual holding State registration certificate loses their certification.



Duties of the Chief of Police:
□ To do inspections;
□ Verify MME employee and agent
registration cards (State-issued);
□ Establish "Safety Plan and □
Operational Requirements" and
regulate MMEs for compliance;
□ Recommend license revocation to City
Council when warranted.

Other City officials and officers may also inspect MMEs.

PROPOSED CODE – FEES

Base fee:

\$3,000 per year for cultivation facilities and facilities for the production of edible and infused products.

\$5,000 per year for dispensaries.



PROPOSED CODE - FEES

Quarterly fees on gross receipts In addition to base fee and based on MME's gross receipts in excess of \$10,000 for previous quarter: receipts for cultivation or the production of edible and infused products. receipts dispensaries.

PROPOSED CODE - FEES

Independent testing laboratories
Pay license fees in accordance with S.M.C. 5.12.100 (same as most other businesses in Sparks):

☐\$80 per year

☐\$1.00 for each \$1,000 in gross

receipts in excess of \$10,000
