Continuing this item to June 22nd will provide the City time to identify, propose and seek public comment on the expenditure of Community Development Block Grant funding to respond to the COVID-19 emergency. The federal government permitted the use of CDBG funds for these purposes in the Corona Virus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) of 2020.

Council asked how much the City received in supplemental funding; Assistant Community Services Director Armando Ornelas confirmed \$402,633.00. Council asked how the funds might be used to assist local businesses during the pandemic; City Manager Krutz confirmed staff will research options and present to Council at a future meeting.
