A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE TERMINATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Sparks is a potential subdivision of the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, a local emergency existed in the City of Sparks in accordance with Resolution No. 3309 on the 9th day of February, 2017, as a result, conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property caused a Local State of Emergency to be declared by stating: A MAJOR WINTER STORM EVENT IN THE NORTHERN SIERRA NEVADA WHICH BEGAN ON FEBRUARY 7, 2017 THAT INCLUDES AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF HEAVY RAIN RANGING FROM THE VALLEY FLOOR TO EXTREMELY HIGH ELEVATIONS AROUND THE REGION COUPLED WITH WARM ATMOSPHERIC TEMPERATURES AND A HEAVY AND RIPENED SNOWPACK AND WATER SATURATED GROUND HAS OR WILL RESULT IN BOTH URBAN AND TRUCKEE RIVER FLOODING IN THE CITY OF SPARKS; and

WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril is now deemed to be within the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of and within said City of Sparks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that as of 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 10, 2017, the City Council of the City of Sparks, State of Nevada, does hereby proclaim the termination of said local emergency.
