

Proclamation

WHEREAS, the National Day of Prayer was established by a joint resolution of Congress in 1952 and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman; and

WHEREAS, in 1988, the law was amended and signed by President Ronald W. Reagan, permanently setting the day as the first Thursday of May every year; and

WHEREAS, each year, the President signs a proclamation encouraging all Americans to pray on this day; and in 2005, state governors and governors of several U.S. territories signed similar proclamations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sparks recognizes this special day and joins with Americans across the nation in support of the National Day of Prayer.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GENO R. MARTINI, Mayor of the City of Sparks, Nevada, do hereby proclaim May 7, 2015 as:

"THE NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER"
