

Proclamation

WHEREAS, Keep Truckee Meadows Beautiful, a community funded organization whose numerous programs benefit all of the Truckee Meadows' residents, marks 25 years of stewardship in Northern Nevada with a celebration and fundraiser on October 29, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Keep Truckee Meadows Beautiful (KTMB) is dedicated to creating a cleaner, more beautiful region through education and active community involvement; and

WHEREAS, KTMB was founded by the Biggest Little City Committee in 1989 under the name of Western Nevada Clean Communities and began the Adopt-a-Park program to involve citizens in hands-on volunteer activities to spruce up parks and the Truckee River; and

WHEREAS, all of KTMB's programs are geared toward educating the public about the economic and health hazards of litter and illegal dumping; toward reducing our waste; eliminating trash from our parks, roadways and open spaces; making our community a beautiful and safe place to live; and giving opportunities for residents and businesses to take pride and ownership in their home; and

WHEREAS, KTMB works with more than 3000 volunteers from Northern Nevada and neighboring areas every year to attain the vision of becoming America's cleanest community. More than 90% of every dollar KTMB receives goes directly to programs that clean up the Truckee Meadows and educates our community.
