



Proclamation

WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together Northern Nevada is hosting its inaugural National Rebuilding Day on Saturday, April 24, and,

WHEREAS, the mission of Rebuilding Together Northern Nevada is to revitalize neighborhoods by providing safe and healthy homes for its most vulnerable neighbors, including seniors, veterans, people with disabilities and families with young children, and

WHEREAS, collectively, the affiliates of Rebuilding Together, a national non-profit organization, complete 10,000 projects annually at no cost to homeowners thanks to the help of generous funding and more than 100,000 volunteers, and

WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together Northern Nevada acknowledges that by making improvements ranging from the basic to major home rehabilitations, accessibility modifications, energy-efficient upgrades and community landscaping, varying issues such as health, the environment, the economy and housing can be connected as part of a positive chain reaction that develops into permanent, sustainable change; and

WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together builds partnerships with Nevada's businesses, government and philanthropic communities to assist low- and moderate-income homeowners so they can continue to live in the comfort and safety of their own homes.
