

#### Addendum Number One November 5, 2014

This Addendum No. 1 modifies the Bidding Documents for the 2014 Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility Headworks Improvement Project, and shall become part of the Contract Documents for this Project. In submitting a proposal for this project, each bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum with the proposal package. Failure to so acknowledge may subject the Bidder to disqualification from consideration of contract award.

The Contract Documents are hereby revised and clarified as follows:

#### **General Notes**

- 1. Bid Date. The bid date will remain unchanged at Wednesday, November 12, 2014.
- 2. Power supply for bypass pumping. The TMWRF facility has identified two 560 KVA transformers located just south of the headworks that can be made available for use by the Contractor for bypass pumping. Each transformer is of sufficient size to operate a single 300 HP motor with across-the-line starting, or to operate a 500 HP motor with Solid State Reduced Voltage (SSRV) or Variable Frequency Drive (VFD) starting. The contractor may make use of these transformers for bypass pumping as necessary during the progress of the project. The bidder shall provide and install all needed electrical and mechanical improvements, including pumps, starters, cabling, connections, disconnects, and all other items necessary to provide a safe and workable operating condition. In the event that the bidder wishes to make use of this provision, he shall submit for approval a proposed electrical power plan prior to installation. The power plan shall describe the equipment to be provided, the method of connection, the location and size of cabling, the method of motor starting, a proposed project schedule for bypass duration, and the motor starting characteristics and pump curves for the pumps. The Owner will review this plan for general conformance with plant safe operating practices and to confirm available capacity in the electrical system.
- 3. Contract Time. We have received a request to increase the overall contract time. We believe the request is reasonable, and are hereby increasing the contract time to 360 calendar days.
- 4. A question was received regarding section 100.58 of the specifications, which only allows payment for materials for the bar screens, washer/compactors, and the MCC's. The question was whether additional material payments would be allowed. The answer is that no additional materials payment will be allowed.

- 5. A question was received as to the location of the geotechnical reports for the project. They are located on the Quest web site under Project Q & A.
- 6. A request was received to provide a copy of the record drawings for the 1994 TMWRF project that included bypass pumping at the headworks, as well as any photos that might be applicable. These have been uploaded to the Quest site under the Q & A section.

- 1. Sheet Goo3, Gate Schedule in lower right corner. The schedule does not indicate what type of mounting flange is required for each gate. The Raw Sewage Gates 1 through 4 are to be Cast Iron Sluice Gates mounted to the existing wall thimbles, with custom drilling as required. The two effluent diversion box gates are Stainless Steel gates, and can be either thimble or surface-mounted at the Contractor's option. The 48" North Divider Wall Gate shall be a Stainless Steel gate mounted to the existing wall thimble.
- 2. Sheet D100 and Specification 01025.2.2, clarification regarding the existing cranes. The TMWRF staff would like these cranes to be salvaged, and they shall be removed and delivered by the contractor to a site to be identified by the TMWRF staff on the plant site. 

**Summary:** Staff recommends Council approve the award of contract to K.G. Walters Construction Co., Inc. for construction of the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility (TMWRF) 2014 Headworks Improvements Project for the Total Project Bid in an amount not to exceed \$5,341,600.00 and authorize the Mayor to sign.

#### **Previous Council Action:**

**February 8, 2012** Council approved an Agreement with Stantec for evaluation and design services for the Septage Receiving Facility and Headworks Building at the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation (TMWRF) in the amount of \$377,884, with Reno's share being \$259,242 (Sewer Enterprise Fund).

March 13, 2013 Council accepted staff report regarding the Declaration of the Existence of a local State of Emergency for the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility (TMWRF) pursuant to Chapter 338 and 332 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

September 25, 2013 Council approved an Agreement with Stantec for Engineering Services associated with the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility (TMWRF) Headworks Near-Term Improvement Project in an amount of \$633,702 with Reno's share being \$434,909.68 (Sewer Enterprise Fund).

**Background:** The Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility (TMWRF) is jointly owned by the Cities of Reno and Sparks. The City of Reno oversees the Capital Improvement Program for TMWRF, while the City of Sparks manages operations. The Headworks facility, constructed in 1964, receives raw sewage flows from the entire sewer collection system and pumps it up to the treatment plant.

On February 25, 2013, the City of Reno declared an emergency due to failures occurring in key components of the Headworks operation. Under the emergency declaration, improvements to the Headworks operation were restricted to items that must be immediately repaired to assure continuing operation. The assessment of the need for additional improvements became possible following the establishment of the pumparound. Access to the dry internal spaces of Headworks enabled engineers to assess the condition of the concrete and steel structure and the mechanical and electrical equipment. That assessment identified additional improvements which must be performed in the near-term to assure the sustainable and reliable operation of the Headworks facility.

The previous approved consultant agreement (September 25, 2013), allowed for completion of a design for improvements that address items identified during the assessment.

**Discussion:** This project includes replacement of the odor and hydrogen sulfide gas control system, mechanical screens replacement, sluice gates replacement, concrete repair, flume replacement, handrail replacement, pump motor access facilities, hydraulic system improvements, electrical improvements, surface coatings, and associated items. Bids were opened on November 12, 2014. The lowest responsive and responsible bidder is K.G. Walters Construction Co., Inc. in the amount of \$5,341,600.00. The consideration of approval for an amended agreement with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. for construction services for this project will also be considered by Council at a later meeting, as a separate, but related item.

**Financial Implications:** The City of Reno will administer the agreement and will be reimbursed for a portion of the costs by the City of Sparks through the current cost sharing agreement for TMWRF operation and maintenance. The City of Reno and the City of Sparks share the cost of this project as follows: 68.63% for Reno and 31.37% for Sparks, as shown in Table 1. Costs for the City of Reno are budgeted in the Sewer Enterprise Fund. This project is included in the TMWRF FY2015 Capital Improvement Plan that was approved by the Joint Coordinating Committee.

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends Council approve the award of contract to K.G. Walters Construction Co., Inc. for construction of the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility (TMWRF) 2014 Headworks Improvements Project for the Total Project Bid in an amount not to exceed \$5,341,600.00 (Reno's share being \$3,665,940.08 from the Sewer Enterprise Fund) and authorize the Mayor to sign.
