Supervisor Notes August 31, 2011 – September 26, 2011

Wednesday, August 31

• Talked to Bart at 7:45 a.m. He said he used an air sweeper from California to sweep Mains west of Sparks Blvd; his other sweeper needs a transmission.

Thursday, September 1

• Talked to Bart at 9:05 a.m. about sweeping Sparks Blvd. west. He said he would re-sweep entire area. He was too busy to meet with me to show him the pictures of the swept area. He said he would call me.

Friday, September 2

• Sweeper complaint: Dust on Disc.

Wednesday, September 7

- Check GPS for sweeping on September 6 swept industrial area. Streets not swept: Freeport, Stanford, Marietta Way, Linda Way, Cal Lane, Hardy Way, Dunn Circle, Hulda Way, Packer Way, and Larkin Circle.
- Called Bart at 1:15 p.m. He had driver call me. The driver said there was not enough time to sweep the area. Talked to Bart again and he said he would work it out.

• Finished Zone 4 and started Zone 5 (north of York).
