Plasma Medicines Are Often Used to Treat the Following



IMMUNOLOGY/ NEUROLOGY

Primary immunodeficiency disease (PID), chronic inflammatory demyelinating polyneuropathy (CIDP), and certain potentially life-threatening situations where rapid immune coverage is needed



HEMATOLOGY

Hemophilia and other bleeding disorders that can damage tissues and organs due to uncontrolled internal bleeding or excessive clotting



PULMONOLOGY

Alpha-1-antitrypsin deficiency, a genetic condition that can lead to serious lung disease, including emphysema



SHOCK, TRAUMA & BURNS

Plasma medicines can replace lost blood volume and essential blood proteins following trauma, shock and severe burns

1. CHECK-IN

- 18-64 yo Talecris Plasma Resources
- 18-69 yo Biotat & PlasmaCare
- 19 yo in NE
- 2 forms of ID
- At least 110 lbs
- In good health
- Proof of address



2. SCREENING

- Vital signs (Weight, Blood Pressure, Pulse, Temperature)
- Measure your iron levels
- Medical history questions



3. PHYSICAL EXAM

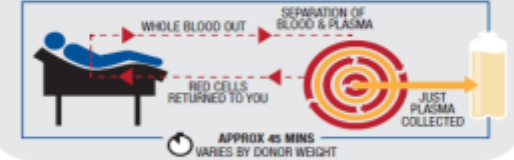
On your very first donation & once a year thereafter



4. DONATION

• When you donate plasma the process is called plasmapheresis (plaz-mah-fair-EE-sis). This is a method of removing plasma from the body by withdrawing blood, separating it into plasma and cells, and returning the cells back into the bloodstream.

5. COMPLETION

- Receive compensation
- Plan next donation



6. AFTER CARE

- Your plasma regenerates very quickly
- Take it easy
- Drink lots of water
