

#### **Change in Scheduled Departures by Airport Size**


- U.S. airlines are focusing on

- Regional carriers face less demand for their 50-seat jets and on short-haul flight
- Legacy carriers are focusing on their hubs and reducing flights to markets involving smaller aircraft

#### Thus Far in 2012, U.S. Airlines Have Earned 50 Cents Per Enplaned Passenger





### So Far in 2012, RNO Has Served Over 3.2 Million Passengers





# **Added and Returned Flights**

- Houston United Airlines' non-stop flight to Houston returns in March.
- San Jose Alaska Airlines began non-stop flights to San Jose in June 2012
- Ontario Southwest Airlines began non-stop flights to Ontario on January 6, 2013
- Las Vegas Effective February 1, 2013, Allegiant Air will offer twice weekly non-stop flights to Las Vegas
