WHEREAS, public works services provided in our community are an integral part of our residents' everyday lives; and

WHEREAS, the support of an informed citizenry is vital to the efficient operation of our public works programs and components such as engineering (design, construction, and traffic), maintenance (traffic safety, collection, facilities, streets, and fleet) and wastewater (collection, treatment, and reuse); and

WHEREAS, the health, safety, and comfort of this community greatly depend on these facilities and services; and

WHEREAS, the quality and effectiveness of our public works services and facilities, as well as their planning, design, construction, maintenance, and operation, are vitally dependent upon the efforts and skill of our public works staff; and

WHEREAS, the efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff public works departments is materially influenced by the community's understanding of the importance of the work they perform.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GENO R. MARTINI, Mayor of the City of Sparks, Nevada, do hereby proclaim May 19-25, 2013 as:

"NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK"

and call upon all residents and civic organizations to recognize the contributions which public works officials make every day to our health, safety, comfort and quality of life.
