This Memorandum of Understanding is between the City of Sparks, Nevada, a municipal corporation ("City"), and the Sparks Police Protective Association Covering Lieutenants ("SPPA Lieutenants").

WHEREAS, the City and SPPA Lieutenants entered into a multi-year collective bargaining agreement for the period beginning July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020, which Agreement was approved by the Sparks City Council on September 25, 2017 (the "Agreement");

WHEREAS, SPPA Lieutenants are members of the Sparks Police Protective Association; and

WHEREAS, the City and SPPA Lieutenants have agreed to change the effective date for the range adjustment for Lieutenants for the year of 2019 as set forth in Section 2: Pay Rates, Article A: Pay Rates, Subsection 3: Range Adjustment;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree that Section 2: Pay Rates, Article A: Pay Rates, Subsection 3: Range Adjustment is hereby amended as follows:

2. Range Adjustment. A range adjustment increasing the minimum and maximum of the range will be applied each year based on the July 11, 2016 base payrates. The range adjustments will be the following:

Effective Date	Percentage
07/10/2017	1.8% of July 11, 2016 base pay
07/09/2018	2.5% of July 11, 2016 base pay
07/08/2019	2.8% of July 11, 2016 base pay
10/01/2018	2.8% of July 11, 2016 base pay

This Memorandum of Understanding shall take effect upon approval by the parties and be valid through and including June 30, 2020.
