WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril is now deemed to be within the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of and within said City of Sparks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that as of 5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 27, 2017, the City Council of the City of Sparks, State of Nevada, does hereby proclaim the termination of said local emergency.
