- consider using other public lands (89% of NV is federally owned)

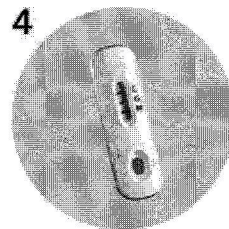
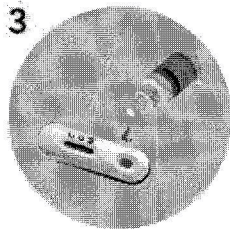
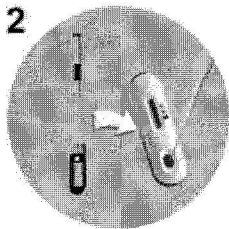
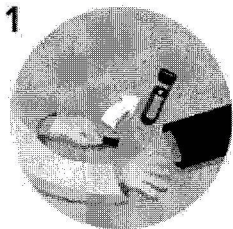
