## Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, the National Day of Prayer was established by a joint resolution of Congress in 1952 and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1988, the law was amended and signed by President Ronald W. Reagan, permanently setting the day as the first Thursday of May every year; and

**WHEREAS**, each year, the President signs a proclamation encouraging all Americans to pray on this day; and in 2005, state governors and governors of several U.S. territories signed similar proclamations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sparks recognizes this special day and joins with Americans across the nation in support of the National Day of Prayer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, RONALD E. SMITH**, Mayor of the City of Sparks, Nevada, do hereby proclaim May 2, 2019 as:

**“THE NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER”**
