# We're not who we once were

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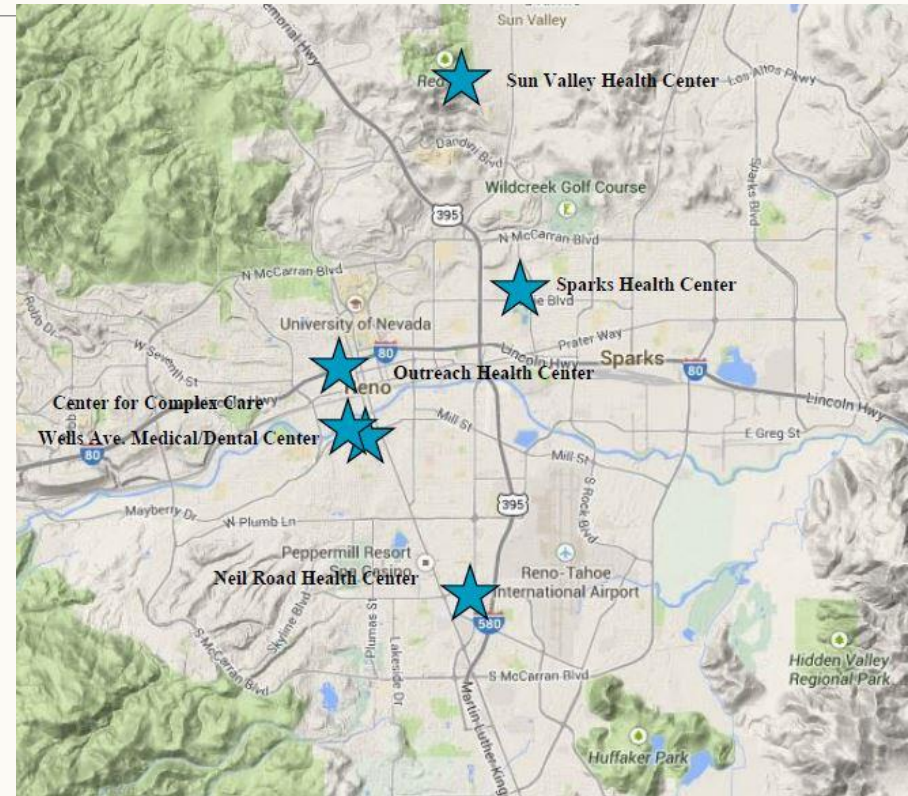
- Formerly known as HAWC (Healthy Access Washoe County), formed in 1995 to serve the working uninsured

- Help finding a physician or dentist



# Behavioral Health Services

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- Integrating behavioral health into primary care-caring for the whole patient
- Address unhealthy lifestyle habits including:
  - Smoking, overeating, anxiety, substance abuse issues, etc.



# In-House Pharmacy

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- Locations:
  - Wells Ave Health Center
  - Record Street Health Center
  - Sparks Health Center
- Part of the 340 B Program
  - Able to get pharmaceuticals at heavily discounted prices





# Health Care for the Homeless

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- We serve homeless patients at all 6 of our health centers
- Homeless patients are eligible for free services including:
  - Primary medical care
  - Immunizations
  - Lab services
  - Family planning services
  - Prescriptions
  - Dental services
  - Behavioral health services
    - Partnership with Children's Cabinet for services
    - Additional addiction support groups hosted at VOA and Reno Works specific classes

# Transportation Services

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- Transportation is a huge barrier in access to care for patients
- We help facilitate transportation for our patients via partnerships with local taxi companies, RTC, MTM, and AHN Transportation Services



# Healthy Weight Program

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- CHA offers free nutrition counseling services to patients.
- Serves children ages 5-18; children under 5 years can be seen by the WIC Registered Dietitians, CHA Pediatrician and Clinical Psychologist
- Food provided at meetings from FBNN
- Geared towards:
  - Pre-diabetic patients
  - >95<sup>th</sup> percentile BMI for age



# Food Bank of Northern Nevada

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## Bridging Gaps in Food Security:

- Survey given at visit to screen patients for food insecurity
- Permanent food pantry location at our Wells Health Center
- Mobile Pantry site for entire community every 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the month



# Exchange Enrollment Facilitators (EEF) Program

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## Exchange Enrollment Facilitators:

- Connects patients with available resources
- Provides patients with case management services
- Helps patients apply and enroll for insurance and Medicaid
