  - Improved services, new management, expanded programs, and more health center openings







Transportation is a huge barrier in access to care for patients

➢ We help facilitate transportation for our patients via partnerships with local taxi companies, RTC, MTM, and AHN Transportation Services





- >CHA offers free nutrition counseling services to patients.
- Serves children ages 5-18; children under 5 years can be seen by the WIC Registered Dieticians, CHA Pediatrician and Clinical Psychologist
- Food provided at meetings from FBNN
- ➤Geared towards:
  - Pre-diabetic patients
  - >95<sup>th</sup> percentile BMI for age
