WHEREAS, the Blue Star Service Flag is the official banner authorized by the Department of Defense for display by families who have members serving in the United States Armed Forces during a time of war or armed conflict for our nation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sparks has partnered with local chapter, Truckee Meadows Blue Star Mothers, to install banners that grace Victorian Avenue and Victorian Square Plaza, featuring the names and photos of active-duty military service personnel from the Truckee Meadows; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sparks honors the sacrifice and dedication of the Blue Star Mothers of America and the men and women who are defending our nation so we can enjoy the freedoms we have today.
