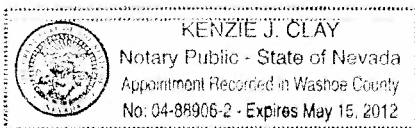

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Public Comment Regarding an Amendment to the  
City of Sparks FY 2011-2012 Annual Action Plan

The FY 2011-2012 Annual Action Plan outlines the activities the City of Sparks will undertake in Year 2 of the FY2010-2014 Consolidated Plan, leveraging Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to address housing, public services, homelessness prevention and physical improvement projects under the objectives of a suitable living environment and decent housing.

This Action Plan amendment specifically addresses: (1) a change in the project area for the City's Pedestrian Improvements activity (approximate allocation of \$275,816 in CDBG funds) from the previously identified streets (i.e., 7<sup>th</sup> Street between Oxford Avenue and Greenbrae Drive; Prospect Avenue and Oxford Avenues between 17<sup>th</sup> Street and Rock Blvd; and/or, Sbragia Way and Russell Way between Rock Blvd and 9<sup>th</sup> Street) to an area with the boundaries of Pyramid Way (west), Prater Way (north), 4<sup>th</sup> Street (east) and Victorian Avenue (north); and, (2) the addition of an activity to provide for certain improvements (new electric gate and fencing, new lighting and cameras, and/or additional shade/seating structures; approximate allocation of up to \$188,000 in CDBG funds) at the Community Assistance Center, the homeless shelter facility located in Reno.

A 30 day public comment period will begin Saturday, December 10, 2011. Copies of the Annual Action Plan and this amendment may be obtained at the address listed below. The public is invited to provide written or verbal comments on this amendment. **Written or verbal comments must be received no later than 2:00 p.m., Monday, January 9, 2012.** In addition, a public hearing on the amendment will be held Monday, January 9, 2012 during the Sparks City Council meeting at 745 Fourth Street, Sparks. Sparks City Council meetings begin at 2:00 pm.
