Space is becoming more of a commodity, as the real estate market continues to thrive.

Making workspace available to creatives and entrepreneurs often makes the difference between activating one's passion and not.

Many people have a tool or two in their garage that they never use, when we all put them in the same space, we found that we could assemble workshops with almost no cost.





History

After building the Temple of Transition, in Reno, in 2011 we got the attention of an Angel Donor.



History

Our first 4 years we did not charge anyone to become a use the facility and join our community.

During this phase:

Training was one on one, project based mentorship.

Over 120 Medium to large art projects were made, over 20,000 overall attendees utilized the space.



Transition to Sustainability Model

In Early 2017 the organization opted to cultivate a long term sustainability, hired a Development Director in June 2017

New model includes three tiers:

Memberships $400 \text{ members} = \frac{1}{2}$

Workshops a month= 1/6

Events, Grants, Donations = $\frac{1}{3}$



Our model is looking sustainable!

We currently have 234 registered Members.

We average 37 daily Members in the space.

YTD we received 12% of funding from Members.

In November we earned 41% of revenue from Membership.


