# Recent Pedestrian Safety Projects

From 2013-2015 RTC Installed

- 43.5 miles of bike lanes
- 18.6 miles of sidewalk
- 318 ADA compliant curb ramps



- 4<sup>th</sup> St/Prater Way BRT**– under construction (2017)
- McCarran/Pyramid Improvements** – under construction (2017)
- SE McCarran Widening/Shared use path** (2015)
- Prater Way** – Stanford to Sparks Blvd – ped ramps/sidewalk/crosswalks (2014)
- El Rancho Dr** – Victorian to Prater – ped ramps/sidewalk/crosswalks (2014)
- Silverada** – Fantastic to 9<sup>th</sup> St – Improved sidewalks & Transit stops (2014)
- Nichols** – Victorian to Howard – Cycletrack with Bike signal @ McCarran (2012)
- Greenbrae Dr** – El Rancho to Sullivan – ADA ramps & sidewalk (2012)
- Prater Way** – View to 22<sup>nd</sup> - ADA ramps & sidewalks (2012)






