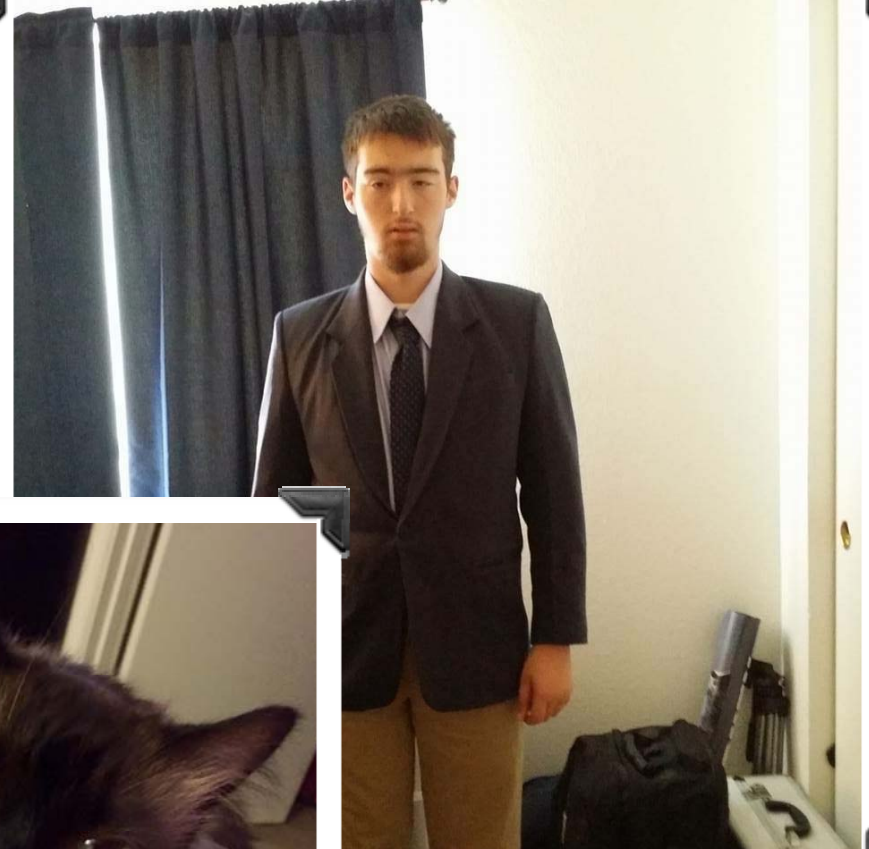

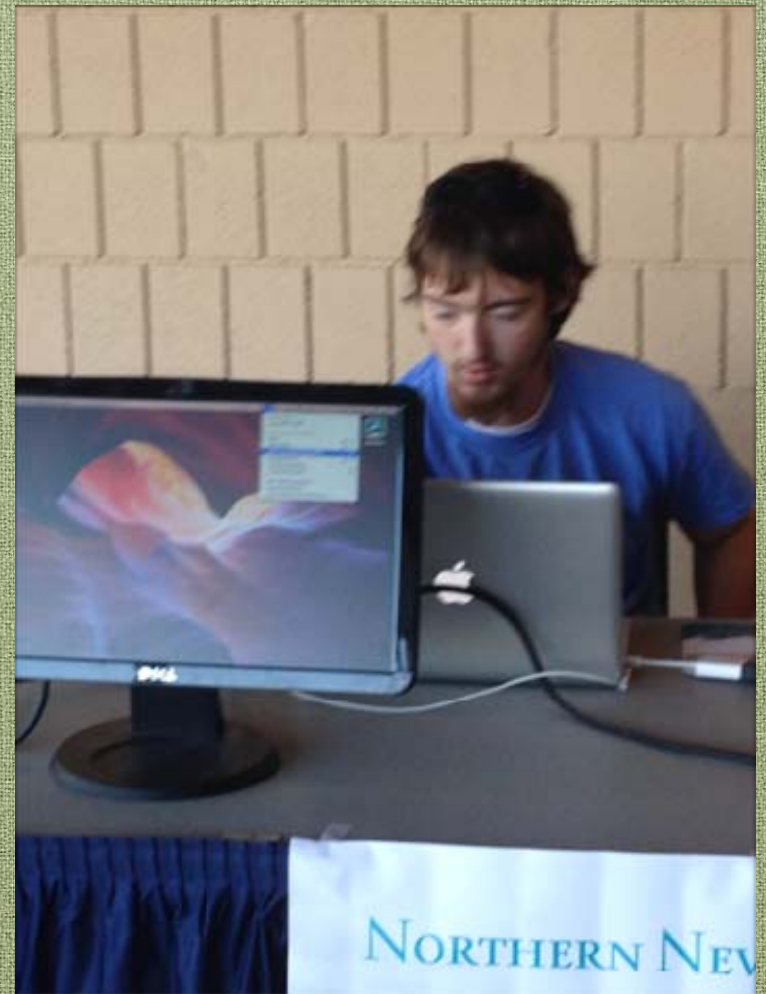

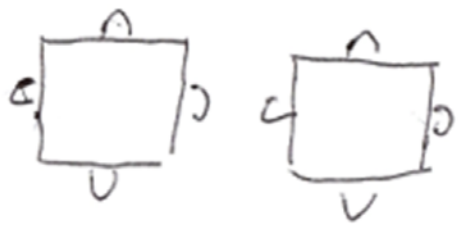
Goals
