This addendum is to notify all potential proposers of clarifications made to the Bid documents as stated below.

1) **NOTE:**

- a. **NOTE THE BID DUE DATE HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO FEBRUARY 11, 2026 AT 2:15 PM WITH THE PUBLIC BID OPENING AT 2:30 P.M. FEBRUARY 11, 2026.**
- b. **ANY SUBSTITUTION REQUESTS SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE PROJECT MANAGER (bmiles@cityofsparks.us, 775-870-2979) NO LATER THAN 4:00 p.m. WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 4, 2026.**
- c. **ALL BID QUESTIONS SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE PROJECT MANAGER (bmiles@cityofsparks.us, 775-870-2979) NO LATER THAN 4:00 p.m. WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 4, 2026.**

- 2) **Poured-In-Place (PIP) Playground Safety Surfacing?** “TOTTURF” as outlined in the plans does not perform prevailing wage projects, so they cannot perform work on this project, but all minimum quality standards are still in place for other manufacturers and installers. Provide all labor, materials, equipment, and tools necessary for the complete installation of a poured-in-place (PIP) playground safety surfacing system (prevailing wage rates are required). Systems shall be designed and installed to meet or exceed the critical fall height requirements of the highest playground equipment. PIP surfacing shall consist of a bonded rubber system installed in accordance with the manufacturer’s recommendations. The finished surface shall be slip-resistant, smooth, and even, and free of defects or trip hazards. The manufacturer shall provide a written warranty covering defects in materials and workmanship for a minimum of three (3) years from the date of Substantial Completion. The color that shall be used for the wear course shall be a green/black 50/50 mixture with the contractor required to submit the manufacturers color palette for final approval. See detail 7 on sheet L5 that outlines the minimum installation requirements for the PIP safety surfacing. All PIP installation labor shall be paid at the current prevailing wage rates for a federally funded project as outlined in the bid specifications.
- 3) **I’m inquiring about BID # 25/26-006 / PWP # WA-2026-184. We are requesting if a General Engineering A license would suffice to bid this project. Please let me know?** The playground installation must be performed by a C-25 licensed contractor with experience installing playground systems.
- 4) **Can the bid date be extended a few days?** Yes, the bid due date has been extended to not later than February 11, 2026 at 2:15 pm. This is to ensure a qualified Poured-In-Place (PIP) contractor using prevailing wage and meeting the minimum qualifications as stated in item 2 of this addendum #2 is met.

- 5) **Will 6' temporary chain link fence be required for the entire perimeter of the project during construction?** Yes, this park is commonly used and park safety will be critical. Bid item 1.0 – Mobilization/Demobilization (page 48 of the bid documents) outlines the requirements of six-foot (6') temporary fence enclosing the work area for the duration of the project.
- 6) **Will the playground safety audit be completed at the cost of the contractor?** No, the City of Sparks has a third-party contractor that is licensed and will perform the audit.
- 7) **Will the CPSI safety audit be required to be a 3rd party separate from the contractor?** See item 6 above in included in this addendum #2.
- 8) **Will the contractor be required to have a CPSI on staff?** No, but the installer must have a current C25 license, per the notes and specifications on sheet L5.
- 9) **NOTE: The project must be completed prior to August 1, 2026 due to federal funding expiration.**

Please note and adjust your bid according to the revisions, additions, deletions, clarifications, or modifications as presented on this Addendum #2, which are made a part of this bid. NOTE: To avoid disqualification, this Addendum #2 (and any other addenda) must be signed by an authorized representative of the bidding firm in the space provided and must be submitted with your firm's sealed proposal. Failure to return this addendum, duly signed, may be cause for rejection of the bid. ALL ADDENDA SHOULD BE SIGNED AND PLACED IN SEQUENTIAL ORDER AND ATTACHED TO THE FRONT OF THE BID PACKAGE, COMPLETE WITH ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS.
